RE: The Duston School – Red Nose Day 2017

On Red Nose Day, Friday 24th March we will be supporting Comic Relief by holding a non-school uniform day.

Red Nose Day is a fundraising event run by Comic Relief that takes place every two years, Comic Relief is a UK based charity, which aims to create a world, free from poverty. Last Red Nose Day the UK public raised an astonishing £99.4 million to help people living incredibly tough lives both here in the UK and Africa.

The money we raise will help people living really tough lives in the UK and across Africa for example, £2.50 could buy a mosquito net to protect a family in Africa. In the UK, £5 could pay for an isolated elderly person with dementia to have dinner at their local support group.

Students are permitted to come into school wearing non-school uniform, in return we ask for a £1 donation from each student payable at the door. Red Noses and Wristbands are also available in The Hub at break and lunchtime for £1.

No midriff tops, shorts or skirts are to be worn, students wearing such items of clothing will be sent home to change.

Any student who does not wish to participate in Red Nose Day 2017 may come to school in full school uniform as usual.
