The film has been created to raise awareness amongst parents/guardians regarding Child Exploitation (CE) and Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE).

Child Exploitation (criminal and/or sexual) is when a young person is targeted by an individual or criminal gang and is manipulated or coerced into committing crimes or sexual acts.

Children can be targeted both in person as well as online via the internet, social media and gaming forums and it's important that, as parents/guardians, we are aware of some of the signs:

- Being away from home more; going to places they wouldn't usually
- Spending time with older people
- Committing anti-social behaviour / low-level crime
- Unexplained injuries
- New and expensive items/gifts (clothing/phones etc)
- Changes in school performance/behaviours
- Missing from school / home
- Having more than one phone

If you have any concerns that your child, or another, is being exploited we urge you to report them to Police via 101 or 999 (if you think your child is in immediate danger). You can also contact Crimestoppers (anonymously) on 0800 555 111, or the NSPCC on 0808 800 5000. [NSPCC: CSE](#)
