ESPRESSO YOURSELF CAFÉ: Drop-ins are available Mondays & Fridays 4-8pm. During lockdown we're not offering group activities or peer support but young people can access 1:1 support with a support worker. This service is for 11-18 year olds, their parents and carers.
