We have been advised that a group of men were hanging around the Greek Church, on St Crispins, at the end of the school day yesterday. They were apparently cat-calling and making inappropriate comments to female students.

As a precaution, over the next few days, we will be increasing our staff presence outside at the end of the school day.

As always, we would emphasise that if any student ever feels that they are at risk of harm when in a public place, at any time, they should contact the police straight away on 999.

We also encourage our students to report any such incidences with us at The Duston School or to any adult that they trust.
