Unique, different, special, similarities, differences,

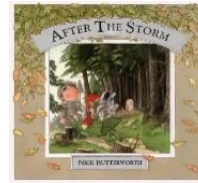
Key Vocabulary

Seasons- four different times of year with different weather.

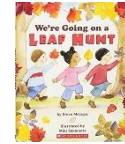
Senses- touch, smell, taste, sight and hear
