Tuition will be split three ways amongst selected students: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tuition to support in Maths and English for those students who have not achieved a grade 4 in maths and English</li> <li>Tuition to support the students above in their other subjects</li> <li>Tuition to support students who have not yet achieved a grade 5 in maths and English or those students eligible for bursary. This is likely to be substantially subsidised by the bursary fund.</li> </ol>					
1. Weekly one hour tuition per subject for either maths or English for any student below a grade 4 in these subjects. This will initially run on a 6 week programme on the run-up to the November resit exams.	£3000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Additional tutoring on a one to one basis or in a small group will provide a personalised approach to target the key areas students may have fallen behind on during the lockdown period.</li> <li>This personalised approach will hopefully allow for more rapid progress in filling any gaps in the curriculum.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tuition primarily will be delivered from in-house staff, who will be asked to produce tuition programmes, assessments and provide regular feedback to the Vice Principal in charge of sixth form.</li> <li>This will be reviewed regularly and amended where necessary.</li> <li>The students involved, the hours taught, the content covered and the progress made will be tracked rigorously by the Vice Principal in charge of sixth form.</li> </ul>	NMO/TWA/ ACL	Reviewed after the initial 6 week period with a similar approach to be in place in the run up to the June exams if tuition is still needed.
2. Students below a grade 4 in English or maths will be able to access tuition in their other subjects. This will be done on an individualised basis with a focus on subjects where students have fallen the most behind over the lockdown period.	£2000			NMO/TWA/ ACL	Reviewed following the mock exams in January.
