In Mathematics we will use addition and subtraction to help Little Bo Peep to count her sheep and compile a 'baa chart' to find out our favourite farmyard animal.

Do cows drink water?

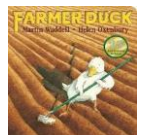
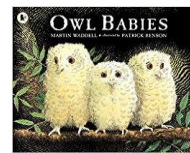
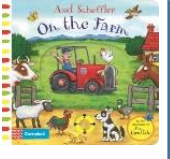
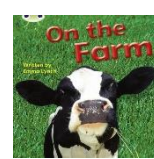
