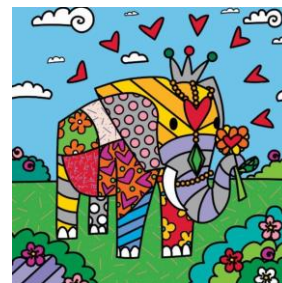


Key Vocabulary:

Pop art	Bright and colourful art based on popular things.
Work of art	Anything made to look or sound nice.
Different	Artists may use different tools or paints.
same	Artists may use the same colours or materials.
