Key Knowledge: Christopher Columbus



- Christopher Columbus was born in 1451, in Italy.
- He died on 20th May 1506, in Spain.
- He was married to Filipa Moniz Perestrelo.
- Christopher had 2 children: Diego and Ferdinand.
- Christopher Columbus was an **explorer** who is famous for his **voyages** across the **Atlantic** Ocean.
- He was the first **European** to set foot on South **America**.

What did Columbus want to discover?

- In the 15th and 16th century, **European** people wanted to find new trade routes to India, China and Japan.
- If someone could find a quicker route, they would be rewarded with money.
- Columbus knew that the earth was round, and believed that
 if he sailed West long enough, that he would eventually get
 to Asia.

Voyages

1st Voyage

- On his first voyage, he had 104 men.
- He was looking for Asia, which he thought he found when they

reached land.

- What he did find was the Bahamas.
- On the same trip he also found Cuba.

2nd Voyage

- On the second voyage, Columbus took 1,200 men.
- He discovered Dominica, Guadeloupe and Jamaica.

3rd Voyage

• On his third trip, he reached the island of Trinidad, and finally the South **American** mainland.

4th Voyage

- His final voyage took him to Central America.
- He reached Panama, and is believed to have found gold there
- The local people forced him to leave and he sailed back to Spain in 1504.

How did he fund his trips?

 Columbus moved from Italy to Spain and was able to persuade King Philip and Queen Isabella of Spain to finance his trips.

Explorer – a person who explores a new or unfamiliar area.

America – A continent made up of North and South America.

Asia – A continent which covers 9% of the Earth's surface.

Europe – A continent located in the Northern Hemisphere.

Sail - travel in a boat.

Sea faring - A person who regularly travels by sea.

Atlantic – The Atlantic Ocean. It is the second largest ocean on Earth.

Voyage – A long journey involving travelling by sea.
