Dear Parents

We are emailing to confirm the arrangements for those of you who have confirmed that you wish for your child to attend when the school reopens for EYFS and Year 1.

From week commencing Monday 8th June

Mondays and Tuesdays

Mrs Almond's class (RA) from 9.00am to 2.45pm

Children are being split into 2 groups:

Green group based in Mrs Almond's classroom

Yellow group based in Miss Mallon's classroom.

Miss Catlin's class (1C) from 9.15am to 3.00pm

Children are being split into 2 groups:

Red group based in Miss Catlin's classroom

Blue group based in Miss Whiteley's classroom.

Thursdays and Fridays

Mrs Mallon's class (RM) from 9.00am to 2.45pm

Children are being split into 2 groups:

Green group based in Mrs Almond's classroom

Yellow group based in Miss Mallon's classroom.

Miss Whiteley's class (1W) from 9.15am to 3.00pm

Children are being split into 2 groups:

Red group based in Miss Catlin's classroom

Blue group based in Miss Whiteley's classroom.

The EYFS and Year 1 teams have contacted you to let you know the group your child will be working in.

*If you have a child in both EYFS and Year 1 or a child in the keyworker group you need to drop off both children at the **latest start time** to their allocated group drop off zone.*

*We would also ask that you collect both children at the **earliest collection time**.*

To keep everyone safe, we ask parents/carers please to arrive at school no earlier than your allotted time to enter and leave. Please also do not stay on the school grounds and please leave immediately as soon as your child is in school. For your safety, please do not stand in large groups around school.

All parents are to enter the school site by the gates opposite the astro turf.

Once at the primary phase building please use the one way system around the perimeter of the school building. Drop off or collect your child from the classroom door that opens onto the playground.

The doors will be labelled with the colour group to assist you.

All primary parents are to exit the school site using the gates by the primary phase (labelled on the diagram below).



Health and Safety

- Children and young people who live in a household with someone who is extremely clinically vulnerable and shielding should not attend. If your child or somebody else in your home has or has recently had COVID symptoms they should not be in school.
- If your child or anyone in the household develops a fever or a new continuous cough they are advised to follow the [COVID-19: guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection guidance](#) (which states that the ill person should remain in isolation for 7 days and the rest of the household in isolation for 14 days).
- If your child shows any symptoms during the school day, they will be isolated immediately and will need to go home as a matter of urgency. Please ensure that the school has up to date parent/carer contact numbers.
- It is advised that all clothes are washed every day after school.
- No bookbags should be brought into school.
- Bikes – If children bike to school the bike needs to be taken home by the parent.

Please Ensure:

- Parents are to ensure that any prescribed medications such as inhalers, epi-pens and so on that your child requires are brought into school as these were returned to you when we closed.
- Only one adult should drop off and collect your child from school. No parents are to enter the classrooms. Please drop off at the classroom door.
- Siblings - When dropping off or collecting your child from school if you are able to leave siblings at home with a responsible adult then please do so. If you are unable to do so siblings can accompany the parent dropping off or collecting – please ensure that social

distancing expectations are followed that siblings stay with the parent dropping off or collecting. Thank you in advance for your support with this.

- Please maintain social distancing expectations.
- Avoid using public transport at peak times.
- **Children are invited to wear their Spring/Summer uniform or their PE kit to school.**
- **Face masks should not be worn by children.**
- **Please apply sun-lotion before your child enters school.**
- **Children should bring a hat/cap to wear.**
- **Please send two healthy snacks into school with your child.**
- **Please send children with a named water bottle that will be returned at the end of each day for washing and refilling.**
- **For those who have elected to provide their own packed lunch.** Please ensure packed lunches are in named disposable containers so that all packaging can be disposed of after the children have eaten their lunch.
