Dear Parents/Guardians/Year 10 and Year 12 pupils,

I do hope you are all well and staying safe. As we look to widen our doors open as of the 22<sup>nd</sup> June I wanted to remind you of the following key points, which are all about keeping all of us safe.

### **Travelling to school via public transport:**

### **If my son/daughter is ill:**

- Pupils who live in a household with someone who is extremely clinically vulnerable and shielding should not attend school. If your son/daughter or somebody else in your home has or has recently had COVID symptoms they should not be in school and you must follow government guidelines for self-isolating. If a child shows any symptoms during the school day, they will be isolated immediately and will need to go home as a matter of urgency. *All parents and guardians must provide up to date contact details to ensure that a parent/guardian can be contacted should any issues arise.* Please do notify the school should your son/daughter have any of the underlying medical conditions falling under the definition Clinically Vulnerable or Extremely Clinically Vulnerable. ### **Pupil Behaviour In-School:**

- We expect pupils to demonstrate exceptional behaviour and to adhere to all teacher instructions.
- Pupils are expected to respect and adhere to the 2 metre social distancing measures that we have in place.

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- Pupils are expected to adhere to the school's one-way system.
- Pupils should not cough or spit in the face of another pupil or member of staff nor should any pupil infringe the 2 metre social distancing expectation that is in place. If a pupil does not follow our clear instructions as a school they will be sent home and potentially excluded.
- Should a pupil need to cough then please cover your face.
- Pupils should have high levels of personal hygiene, washing their hands and ensuring that their school attire is washed daily. Pupils should also utilise the hand sanitiser stations that will be set up as they enter the school site.

### **School Uniform:**

- Year 10 pupils do not need to wear their tank top or the school blazer.
- Year 12 pupils should wear washable smart business attire and male pupils do not need to wear a tie.
