Dear Parents, Guardians and Year 12/13 pupils,

Re: Exam Results Day – Thursday 13th August 2020

I do hope that you are well and staying safe. I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for this year's AS/A2 results day which are sadly, due to the unprecedented national situation, going to be different to normal. Please be advised that the school will email all Year 12 and Year 13 pupils their results directly to their TDS email account. Pupils will not, as per previous result days, be able to come into school to collect their exam results.

I would like to make you aware that if your results are not what you expected then there is no right to appeal. In previous years we could, on the behalf of a pupil, request that exam scripts were remarked or sent back to the school. Due to the nature of the allocation of results this year we will be unable to do this. In short, if a pupil is unhappy with a grade that they have received for a subject the school cannot take any action. We will not be fielding any complaints as a school regarding this, so can I please politely request that you do not complain to the school about your results. I appreciate fully that this goes against the thrust of how we would normally operate.

Pupils in Year 12 will be able to meet with the Sixth Form management team once the new academic year commences to discuss their pathway into Year 13.

Pupils in Year 13 will be able to access UCAS clearing/adjust support if required on results day. Mrs Montagu will email Year 13 pupils directly about this support service that will be offered by the Sixth Form Team.
