**Re: Local Incident**

The Duston School Safeguarding team have been made aware of an incident that took place on Monday after school in the vicinity of St Crispin's carpark/field.

A small group of students, both female and male, reported a man behaving strangely in front of them and towards them. Whilst he did not expose himself fully, the children were concerned by his behaviour and found it distressing.

We would ask that all students that walk/cycle this way to school/home be made aware.

The male was described as approximately 5' 7", white with short dark/grey hair; he was wearing a dark coat (possibly green) and black trousers.

The incident has been reported into Northamptonshire Police – Should anyone have any further information the Police have requested this be shared with them via Incident Number 118 13.03.19.

If any student ever feels that they are risk of harm when in a public place, at any time, they should contact the police straight away on 999.

We also encourage our students to report any such incidences with us at The Duston School or to an adult they trust.
