- Contact you if there is a problem with your child's attendance and punctuality.
- Inform you of any concerns regarding your child's behaviour, work or health.
- Challenge your child to strive for the highest standard of personal, social and intellectual development, and aim for excellence in all they do.

The Parents/Carers will:

- Support the school's vision.
- Encourage my child to do their best, to encourage self-discipline in my child and support the school's policy on behaviour.
- Support my child with homework tasks and ensure that it is handed in on time.
- Make sure that my child wears suitable, named clothing in line with the school's uniform policy.
- Attend meetings at school to discuss my child's progress and to learn about the work of the school.

- Consent to the use of photographic evidence of curricular activities undertaken within the school and visual images on the school website or for other educational purposes.
