

- 1. Tell us the name of the book you want to borrow from our library.
- 2, 7, 12 & 13. Write a short book review about the book you read: Who are the characters? What is it about? No Spoilers! What happened? Why did you like / dislike it? How many stars out of 5 would you give it?
- 3. Tell us how you would be more 'Green' at home.
- 4. Free Audiobooks and Podcasts are available via your smart speaker (Alexa), from the BBC website or from your local library. Either visit them to join, or you can become a virtual member by copying and pasting this link and downloading the BorrowBox App
