### Revision Strategies:

Past papers – Answer and mark past papers, worked solutions help with understanding the question. Then make revision notes/revision cards for topics unsure of/cannot attempt.

Revision cards – Make with key facts, examples and key words.

Work booklets – Keep these from lessons and practice again those questions which you found difficult.

Knowledge organisers – look over these weekly to refresh and recap key information.

Revision Guides – reminder that there are CGP revision guides in the library that you can take out to support your revision. There is enough for every student. Recommend purchasing the workbook that goes alongside these for your practise.

Websites – Use websites to learn, recap and revise specific topics and exam style questions. Make a note of anything you were not confident on, relearn the topic and try the questions again.

Practice – You can always do maths. Practice makes permanent.

Be kind to yourself when revising – When revising work for 15-30 minutes, rest for 10-15 and repeat.
