Revision Strategies:

1. Test yourself: Test yourself regularly using flashcards, quizzes, or past paper questions. Focus on key topics and use purchased revision guides/knowledge organisers to recap key knowledge. Use tools like Quizlet or create your own flashcards with definitions and case study facts.
2. Revision timetable: Use a revision timetable to revisit content at increasing intervals.
3. Case study knowledge: Create summary sheets for each case study. Include location, causes, impacts, and responses. Practice applying case studies to different types of exam questions.
4. Past papers: Complete past papers under timed conditions. Focus on interpreting command words like *describe*, *explain*, *evaluate*. Review mark schemes to understand examiner expectations.
5. Revision support: Use Revision Websites – see below for more information.
6. RAG confidence: Keep your work booklets in a safe place and use checklists to RAG your confidence.

The Geography department have access to a range of revision resources such as question booklets, revision sheets, checklists and glossary notes. If there is anything that you are looking for and don't have access to, please speak to your teacher.

- **Physics & Maths Tutor** - Provides summary notes, glossaries, flashcards, case studies, and past papers and is structured by component and topic, making it easy to navigate.
- **Pearson Edexcel Official Resources** - Includes Student Books, ActiveBooks, intervention workbooks, and revision guides that can be purchased.
