Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Year 9 Bletchley Park – Friday 10th July 2026

To support KS3 Maths and History we are organising an educational trip to Bletchley Park in Milton Keynes on Friday 10th July 2026. This is an exciting opportunity for students to experience a range of activities related to the history and working around the enigma machines during WW2.

Students will have the opportunity to look at the following historical and mathematical questions:

- What is the enigma machine?
- How did code breakers help to end the war?
- What was life like for people working at Bletchley Park?

Students will travel by coach, departing from The Duston School at 9am and returning at approximately 3:30pm. Students must wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch and water bottle with them. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, they will be able to collect a packed lunch from the school canteen.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution* of £25.62 per student for the trip to run. This covers the cost of entrance, coach travel, parking and insurance. Whilst we are only able to ask for contributions towards school trips, it is important to note that if we are unable to cover costs, the trip will not take place. Contributions can be paid via ParentPay.

For those pupils for whom the school receives Pupil Premium funding the trip will be fully funded by the school and there will be no charge to parents/guardians. The payment item will still show on your ParentPay, but no payment is required.

Both contributions and the consent form need to be completed and paid by Sunday 26th April 2026.
